Program Overview

The AAACE Metro New York Section announces the upcoming Call for Technical Papers. Over the next several months, members and guests will have the opportunity to develop a technical paper for submission and publication by the Section. The program will comprise a kick-off meeting, explaining the basics of developing a technical paper along with the many benefits of doing so. In early summer 2022, the AAACE Metro NY section will be hosting a live and in-person networking opportunity for our emerging professionals and seasoned industry experts alike to establish mentoring relationships that will aid in the development of technical papers. In the fall, the Section leadership will evaluate and rank the papers. **The primary author of the highest-ranked paper will win a trip to the next AAACE Annual Conference & Expo June 11-14, 2023, in Chicago, Illinois.**

Here is what you need to know:

- The competition is open to primary authors with five years or less of professional experience
- Primary authors may work with mentor(s) of any experience level
- Only one primary author will be eligible for the all-expenses paid trip to the 2023 annual conference

Timeline:

April 27, 2022, 5:00PM: Virtual program kick-off. Section leadership will explain the ground rules of the competition. Special Guest, Christopher Carson FRICS, FAACE, FGPC, CCM, PMP, PSP, CEP, DRMP will explain the benefits of writing technical papers and provide helpful tips and recommendations for writing papers.

June 2022 (exact date to be confirmed): In-person networking event, to provide opportunities for emerging members to network and meet mentors for the technical paper writing experience.

August 31, 2022, 5:00PM: Deadline for paper submissions to Section Leadership. Submit your paper to info@aaacei-nyc.org

September 30, 2022, 5:00PM: Section leadership will announce the highest-ranked paper and award the Air Travel; Hotel Accommodation & Conference Fee expenses paid trip to the next AAACE Annual Conference & Expo to the primary author.
